During the month of January the virtue we focus on is **SELF-CONTROL**. Temperance, represented by an olive wreath is the cardinal virtue that crowns our decisions and joys with a holy balance and right discipline. Another word for the olive wreath is the *kotinos*, with which winning athletes in ancient Greece were presented. By temperance we all win the "prize" of self-control and true peace. If we learn self-discipline we practice self-control and are using the Cardinal Virtue of Temperance. With another new year beginning, many of us make resolutions or promises. What a perfect time this is to learn to control our words or actions and practice this new virtue!

During the month of February the virtue on which we focus is **HONESTY**. Being honest is being open, trustworthy and truthful. WOMEN'S CARE CENTER COLLECTION THIS WEEK

The 7th grade is sponsoring the annual Women's Care Center Baby Shower during Catholic Schools Week, January 29 - February 2. Please check the list below to see what each grade level is requested to donate. Thank you in advance for your generosity for our service project!

- Kindergarten: pull-ups (2T/3T), pacifiers, cotton sleepers (any size)
- Grade 1: pull-ups (4T/5T), sippy cups, fleece blanket sleepers (any size)
- Grade 2: diapers (newborn), receiving blankets, onesies/shorts/pants (3-6 months)
- Grade 3: diapers (size 1), onesies/shorts/pants (9-12 months), new/gently used books (0-2 years)
- Grade 4: diapers (size 2), onesies/shorts/pants (18-24 months), new/gently used books (3-6 years)
- Grade 5: diapers (sizes 3), crib blankets, any season shirts/shorts/pants (2T)
- Grade 6: diapers (sizes 4), white booties/socks, any season shirts/shorts/pants (3T)
- Grade 7: diapers (size 5), baby soap, lotion, shampoo, any season shirts/shorts/pants (4T)
- Grade 8 & Life Skills Class: diapers (size 6), wipes, hooded bath towels, washcloths

ATTENTION: Parents of current 5th grade students regarding 3 vaccinations.

The new Hepatitis A vaccine requirement for entrance to 6th grade starts this month!

HEPATITIS A -- is a series of two vaccinations given 6 months apart. You must start the first vaccination this month (**JANUARY**) in order to be able to **complete the second dose prior to the first day of school.**

Also, remember a Tdap vaccination and a Meningitis vaccination are required once your child turns 11 years old. HPV vaccine (human papilloma virus) is recommended to prevent a cancer but is not a requirement. (*Information regarding HPV is located on our school website.)

A form is due in the office from the doctor or provider that gave these three required vaccinations no later than the very first day of school in August. This is mandated by Indiana Code 20-34-4-2 and IC 4-22-2. It is best to make plans today and do not delay! This is a second notice.

ATTENTION: Parents of students entering K-4 next year. This is just for your information.

The Hepatitis A Vaccination was extended to 4th graders for our next school year. (I believe everyone to be up-to-date. However, I will contact you if your child is missing any vaccinations or some were given too soon and need to be repeated.) Please, do not send in copies of immunizations unless contacted to do so.

3 Hepatitis B	2 MMR

Hepatitis A vaccine continues to be on a 'catch up' schedule. It will eventually be a requirement for all grade levels.

Parents can put money into the student's account through your MealpayPlus online account at www.mealpayplus.com or by calling 866-662-3382 for a small fee. Or, you may send a check with the Lunch Accounting Form below to the school cafeteria. For example, if you have 3 children, send a check for \$90 payable to St. Charles Cafeteria and designate \$30 to each child's account. Each child who will eat hot lunch needs to have money in their meal account. It is recommended to have a minimum of \$13.00 in this account which will pay for five meals. If the student may want additional portions of the main entree, then it is recommended to have a minimum of \$6.00 in the general account as well. If you have questions regarding this, you may call the school cafeteria at 969-4028 on school days 8:00-12:30 or the school office at 484-3392.
