School Pictures - The 8th grade students received their picture proofs yesterday. These students need to select their pose, picture package, and place their order by Tuesday, October 15. Orders may be returned to school with payment or placed online with a credit card.

Students in grades PreK-7 should receive their picture packages any day. If parents did not order a package, the student will receive an "It's not too late." form with information about ordering a picture package.

If students were absent on picture day, we have no photo. **Make-up pictures** will be taken on **Monday, October 21**. Students should request an order envelope from the school office and bring it to school on the 21st or parents may place their order and pay online inter-state.com/FlyerEntry/39768HF Students who are having their picture taken on that day may dress up.

If parents are not pleased with the picture that was taken, simply return the entire package on the 21st with your student. Your student may dress up and have their photo re-taken that day. A new order form is not needed for re-takes, but the original package needs to be returned. Thank you.

All Schools' Mass at the Coliseum, Tuesday, October 15th

Every year in the fall, Bishop Rhoades celebrates Mass with the Catholic school students on the east of the diocese at the Coliseum. He celebrates a similar Mass for those on the west end of the diocese later in the year. This year, the Mass is Tuesday, October 15, at 10:30 am. St. Charles' students in grades 3-4-7-8 will attend the Mass. Students are asked to **wear their red** uniform shirts **with long pants**. Girls may wear their plaid jumpers or skirts. The students will have assigned seating and there will be additional reserved seats for those who just come in. If you are not driving a group of students and wish to attend, you are welcome. Ushers will seat you.

The Catholic Schools' Office has asked all the schools to arrange a food drive for the school. We are to take our donations with us to the Coliseum and deposit the food in the barrels provided by Community Harvest Food Bank as we enter the Expo area. Most needed items are: canned protein (chicken, beef, tuna, salmon), peanut butter, canned fruits, canned beans, canned soup, canned vegetables, dry goods (beans, rice, pasta), boxed dinners (Hamburger Helper, Tuna Helper, Rice-A-Roni). Food items should be brought to school by all students and those attending Mass will take theirs and the food of those not attending.

Or, you may send a check with the Lunch Accounting Form below to the school cafeteria. For example, if you have 3 children, send a check for \$90 payable to St. Charles Cafeteria and designate \$30 to each child's account. Each child who will eat hot lunch needs to have money in their meal account. It is recommended to have a minimum of \$14.00 in this account which will pay for five meals. If the student may want additional portions of the main entree, then it is recommended to have a minimum of \$6.00 in the account as well. 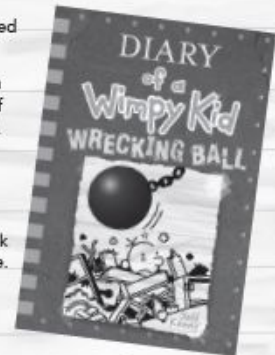
