Celebrating Catholic Schools! – As many of you probably know, next week we celebrate Catholic schools. Many things have been cancelled this year; and while we won't be able to do all of the things we typically do to celebrate our Catholic schools, celebrate we will.

How will SCRIP participate in the celebration? We usually do a special giveaway and because everyone has given up so much this year, SCRIP wants to reward all the efforts and sacrifices our school families have endured in order to continue our "in-person" education. Be sure to place a SCRIP order this week, you can't win if you don't place an order. Any order placed *Friday, January 29 – Sunday February 7* for \$100 or more will qualify. If you have never used SCRIP before, this would be a great time to start; it will be worth it!

\$CRIP Rebates – The SCRIP rebate statements for the second half of 2020 are available. Yours should have come home with one of your students on January 18. Check the redemption of choice, *sign the statement*, and turn it back into the SCRIP team. Look carefully at the redemption choices. In addition to the usual choices, St. *Vincent DePaul* ministry has been added. This parish ministry works hard to help the needy of our parish and that need has been great this past year.

Weather Delays – It has certainly looked and felt a lot like winter this week. Weather delays do affect our Friday morning sales in the Hession Center. Parents can put money into the student's account through your MyPaymentPlus (formerly MyMealsPlus) online account at <a href="www.mypaymentplus.com">www.mypaymentplus.com</a> or by calling 1-877-237-0946 for a small fee. Or, you may send a check with the Lunch Accounting Form below to the school cafeteria. For example, if you have 3 children, send a check for \$90 payable to St. Charles Cafeteria and designate \$30 to each child's account. Each child who will eat hot lunch needs to have money in their meal account. It is recommended to have a minimum of \$14.00 in this account which will pay for five meals. If the student may want additional portions of the main entree, then it is recommended to have a minimum of \$6.00 in the account as well. if you have questions regarding this, you may call the school cafeteria at 969-4028 on school days 8:00-12:30 or the school office at 484-3392.
