1. Death of a St. Charles Parent: I am saddened to share the news that Mr. Peter James unexpectedly passed away Monday evening. I know that we will all keep the soul of Mr. James and the well-being of the family in our prayers. 2. Voucher Update: We have an IDOE Choice meeting on May 5th to clarify how the new Choice Scholarship (Voucher) expansion will affect families for this coming year. As soon as we have clarification, we will send out a detailed update to all.
3. Federal Free Lunch for all students has been expanded to include the 2021-2022 school year. This also helps many families.
4. Thank you to Mr. Hoersten and all of our teachers and staff who assisted with wrapping up ILearn Testing this week. Most of our students in grades 3-8 will wrap up ILearn Testing this week. We are down to a handful of students who need to test!
5. Regarding the anti-masking protests this past Tuesday: I appreciate that the right to peacefully protest is what makes America great, but I would have been more appreciative if those who protested had picketed at the Capital or at the Mayor's office. We are all tired of masking, but it was a bit disheartening to our faculty and staff who have worked so hard this year keeping students safe, learning, and moving in a positive direction to have some of our own parents protesting outside the school.
6. On the same note, I meant to address the topic of adults posting negative comments about our school or parish. I don't use Facebook, but people often send us screenshots of various school/Church-related posts. Please, if you have an issue just talk to Fr. Tom or me. We are called to be role models. Publicly posting negatively does not build community or God's Kingdom.
7. Thanks to those who shared the following positive Facebook note with teachers & staff. *"For my friends who go to St. Charles Church, please get this post to the principal and staff. Today as we left the church during my aunt's funeral, there were many children out at recess. They stopped and lined up facing us. Some knelt in prayer. They stopped playing to show respect and reverence to my family and my aunt. It was a wonderful moment. You should all be very proud. #lovebeingCatholic".* I am thankful our playground monitors asked the students to pause and pay respects. Monsignor Suelzer had hoped that we could do this & with smaller playground groups, this has organically grown through our monitors' direction and our students' caring.

JUMPSPARK SPRING READING PROGRAM - Sunday, April 18, the Allen County Public Library launched a program called JumpSPARK! SPARK stands for Science, Play, Art, Reading and Knowledge. [JumpSPARK](#) is a board game-inspired program and will give children, teens, and families a "jump start" on ACPL's popular Summer Learning Program. JumpSPARK runs through May 31 and provides a new opportunity for families to read together and engage in fun activities. 21st Century Scholars Program

Your children may be eligible for college tuition through the 21st Century Scholars program. Students in the 7th or 8th grade who qualify for the program can receive up to four years of college tuition to attend an eligible Indiana public or private college or university. The scholarship may be reduced depending on the availability of the student's family to contribute to college. Income guidelines:

* The scholarship amount may be reduced depending on the availability of funds and the availability of the student's family to contribute to college. **The only time you can apply for this program is when the student is in 7th or 8th grade. Students must be enrolled by June 30th of their eighth grade year!!**
